

List of species destined for the aquatics market banned from import into the European Union

- *Blastomussa spp.* (Coral) alive or dead, wild and only from Indonesia
- *Catalaphyllia jardinei* (Coral) alive or dead, wild and only from Indonesia and the Salomon islands
- *Cheilinus undulatus* (Fish) alive or dead, wild and only from Indonesia
- *Cynarina lacrymalis* (Coral) alive or dead, wild and only from Indonesia
- *Euphyllia cristata* (Coral) alive or dead, wild and only from Indonesia
- *Euphyllia divisa* (Coral) alive or dead, wild and only from Indonesia
- *Euphyllia fimbriata* (Coral) alive or dead, wild and only from Indonesia
- *Hippopus hippopus* (Clam) alive or dead, wild and only from New-Caledonia, Tonga, Vanuatu and Vietnam
- *Hydnophora microconos* (Coral) alive or dead, wild and only from Indonesia
- *Montipora caliculata* (Coral) alive or dead, wild and only from Tonga
- *Plerogyra spp.* (Coral) alive or dead, wild and only from Indonesia
- *Scolymia vitiensis* (Coral) alive or dead, wild and only from Indonesia
- *Strombus gigas* (Shellfish) alive or dead, wild and only from the islands of Antigua and Barbuda, Barbados, Dominica, Haïti, Trinidad and Tobago
- *Trachemys scripta elegans* (Florida turtle) live, wild or captive bred, from every country
- *Trachyphyllia geoffroyi* (Coral) alive or dead, wild and only from Indonesia
- *Tridacna crocea* (Clam) alive or dead, wild and only from Fiji, Tonga, Vanuatu and Vietnam
- *Tridacna derasa* (Clam) alive or dead, wild and only from Tonga, Fiji, New-Caledonia, Philippines, Palau and Vanuatu
- *Tridacna gigas* (Clam) alive or dead, wild and only from Fiji, The Marshall islands, Indonesia, Micronesia, Palau, Papou-New-Guinea, Tonga, Vietnam and Vanuatu
- *Tridacna maxima* (Clam) alive or dead, wild and only from Fiji, The Marshall islands, Micronesia, New-Caledonia, Mozambique, Tonga, Vanuatu and Vietnam
- *Tridacna squamosa* (Clam) alive or dead, wild and only from Fiji, Mozambique, New-Caledonia, Tonga, Vanuatu and Vietnam
- *Tridacna tevoroa* (Clam) alive or dead, wild and only from Tonga

These species cannot therefore be legally imported into the European Union if they are from one of the countries cited. Note that the sale of banned species is a serious offence punishable by law.
